PILOT AND APPRENTICE DRESS CODE

TO: SANDY HOOK PILOTS AND APPRENTICES

The Board has been informed that there has been a relaxation in the appearance and presentation of State Pilots aboard ship.

The Board reminds all State Pilots and Apprentices to be appropriately attired when presenting as a pilot aboard ships entering, departing, and transiting the Port of New York and New Jersey.

The Board expects, as does the Sandy Hook Pilots Association (SHPA), appropriate attire to be worn as outlined in the Association's previous correspondence to Pilots and Apprentices in this regard:

Men

- Dress shirts that include buttons, collar and a tie
- Dress slacks/pants/khakis
- Blazer/sports coat, weather permitting
- Safe Practical dress boots or shoes

<u>Women</u>

- Blouses that include a collar and sleeves
- Dress slacks/pants/khakis
- Sweaters
- Safe Practical dress boots or shoes

During times of excessively warm weather, it is acceptable for Pilots and Apprentices to wear a blue polo shirt with an SHPA insignia.
